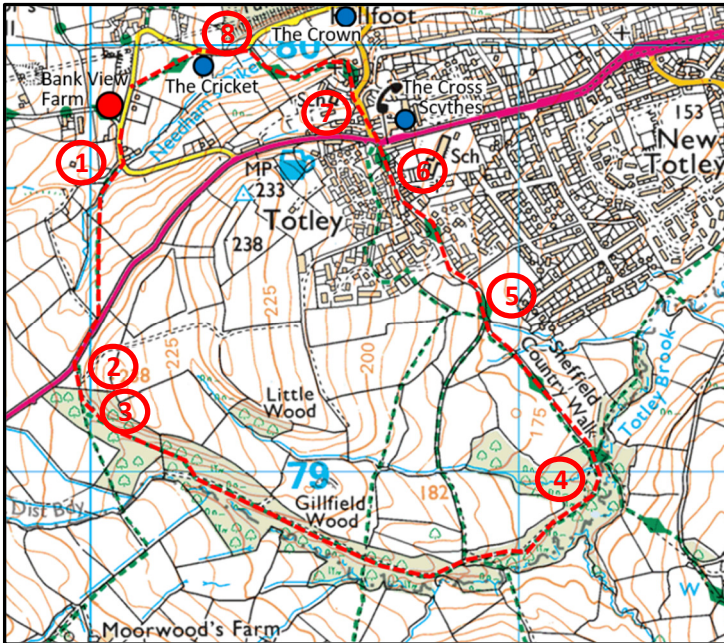


Bank View Farm : Luxury Bed & Breakfast

Walk 3 : Through Gillfield Woods and Totley Old Village

2.5 miles / 4.0km – Approx. 1.5 hours

A steep start is rewarded with a lovely path down through the woods ending with a walk through the historic Totley Old Village, and back past The Cricket Inn for potential refreshments!



To start, drop down to Lane Head Road at the bottom of the farm and turn right.

1. After 100 yards take a track on the right next to the stream, and 50 yards down the track take the stile on your left and cross a small bridge. Follow the path up the hill and to the right, over a couple of stiles. (This will be muddy after wet weather)

2. In the corner of the field go over a steep stile and onto the main road. A few yards up the main road cross and go over a stile onto a path on the other side of the road.

3. The path cuts across the bottom of the field to a stile opposite (do not follow the track up the hill). This takes you into the woods where you turn left and take the main (middle of three paths) down through Gill Field Wood. Follow this for over 1km down through the woods.
4. When you get to a major path junction turn left up a steep path to a stile which takes you into a field. Follow the path through the fields and over a couple of stiles.
5. When you hit a track turn right and go over another stile and onto a road. Follow this through the old village with Totley Hall and Totley Hall Farm on your left and Totley Church down a steep drive on your right.
6. At the main road cross on the pedestrian crossing and turn left and first right down Hill Top sign posted to Dore.
7. After 100 yards you pass a small garden area on your left on the site of the old Pinfold and then take Chapel Walk, a track on the left. After going through a few houses this drops steeply down the hillside through some woods.
8. At the bottom you cross a small stream and reach a road (Penny Lane). Turn left, walk past the Cricket Inn, take the gate on your left immediately after the Inn and walk around the Cricket Pitch and back to Bank View Farm at the far side.
